## DONNELLY RIVER VILLAGE

Monday 27 June – Thursday 30 June 2016

Cost: \$500 per person (limited of 15 participants)

**Includes: 3 nights accommodation, breakfast and lunch, painting materials and tuition.**

Accommodation is based on two people sharing a cottage – each person will have a private bedroom, and share a kitchen, bathroom and lounge with wood fire (firewood supplied).

There are lots of accommodation options at Donnelly River Village – most cottages regularly sleep 6-8. If you're thinking of coming as a bigger group, you can book a series of cottages in a row, try Monohan Lodge (larger and a bit fancier than the workers' cottages) with four bedrooms it sleeps 12 or The Old Boarding House which has a spacious living area and monster kitchen. It sleeps 12 and has five bedrooms.

**Meals:** Breakfast will be served at the General Store where we will meet each morning to map out plans for the day's painting. A packed lunch will be provided so you'll be able to take it in the field (or on to the verandahs). Coffee and tea making facilities will be set up for you to use throughout the day. **Please let us know about any special dietary requirements before 1 June 2016.** Dinners will be self-catered, the cottages have stoves, microwaves, fridge/freezers. The Donnelly General Store only has a small selection of staples - they do have fabulous coffee and cake - so we really recommend bringing everything you need from Perth or planning a stop in Bridgetown, Nannup or Manjimup enroute to pickup the supplies for evening meals (don't forget the wine and cheese). There will be night classes or activities so communal cooking/sharing evening meals maybe an option, we'll keep you updated.

**Materials:** We'll provide a pochade box for each person (painting box on tripod), painting boards (215 x 255mm), oil paints, medium and brushes. If you have particular paints, brushes and boards you like to use, please bring them along.

**What to bring:** You need to bring sheets, doonas, blankets, pillowslips and towels for your stay or choose to use the linen hire service and linen will be delivered to your cottage (please let us know when you book if you'd like to use this service). Warm and dry clothing, hat, rain gear and sunscreen (prepare for all weathers). Creature comforts - thermos, water bottle, snacks, wine, cheese, and perhaps a hot water bottle if you really feel the cold. Ken also recommends you bring a sketchbook and camera (or phone/camera).
